What started as a way to find a cure for one, has grown into a passion to find a way to fight blindness for all and make a difference for many.




#### Events & Fundraising

### WHIP PROJECT

Seconds can save a life. During a recent tornado we realized just how difficult it is for someone with hearing loss to react quickly in an emergency. This project launched from this trauma and is Abby's brain-child. She started "WHIP" (Warning Hearing Impaired People) ... to help put alarm systems into homes of the hearing impaired. We did a lot of research and have a great system that is easy to install and portable. Our goal is to get it into as many homes as we can of those in need. We are working with local fire departments to make these available for free in your area.
